

Nebraska Nurse Preceptor Survey

In 2023, MCIRN conducted a survey of preceptors of nurses across Nebraska to describe factors that help or hurt their ability to train new nurses, and determine what preceptors need to feel prepared and supported.



Other responses included reduced tuition (24%), free continuing education (33%), license/certification (30%)

Nebraska Nurse Preceptor Landscape

Nurses were asked to describe one issue that if fixed would improve preceptor experience. Top responses include:







Not enough full-time nurses to precept number of trainees

Too many temporary traveling nurses

Experiencing burn out from workload



High patient load with not enough time for teaching
